NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc will apply
- 1.3 The Class Rules of the Classes represented will apply.
- 1.4 Racing rule 44 is amended. See paragraph 12.2 of this Notice.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Jack Holt Regatta is open to all boats of the classes designed by Jack Holt. Examples include, Heron, Mirror, International Cadet, National E (Lazy E), Pacer, Solo, GP14 and Enterprise.
- 3.2 The May Day Regatta is open to all other dingy Classes.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and presenting it, together with the required fee, to the race desk LCSC before 1100H on 05/05/2012.
- 3.4 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

4 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

- 5.1 \$75.00 per boat. Subsequent boats from the one family \$50.00. Entries from a School Sailing Club will be regarded as a family entry.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Registration:

- 7.2 Measurement and inspection:
Day and date: Saturday 5th May 2012 From 1000H To 1100H
- 7.3 Dates of racing:

06/05/12 racing
07/05/12 reserve day
- 7.4 Number of races:
Number *Races per day*
7 Up to 4

The reserve day may be used if races are not completed as scheduled or if the race committee considers it unlikely that races will be completed as scheduled.

- 7.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first day is 1230H
The scheduled time of the warning signal for subsequent days is 0900H
If the reserve day is required a notice shall be placed on the regatta notice board before 1900H on 06/05/12. Code Flag L and a sound signal will signal this change.

8 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement rating certificate.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available upon registration.

10 VENUE

10.1 Lake Cootharaba off Boreen Point.

11 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed, subject to confirmation in the sailing instructions, will be as follows: Start: Marks 1, 2, 3, 1, 3: Finish

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The penalties are as follows: One Turn.

12.2 For the Regatta, rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

12.3 Protests must be submitted within 1 hour of the last boat finishing that day.

13 SCORING

13.1 The Low Point System will apply.

13.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14, 15, 16, 17 Not used

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19 PRIZES

All places will be determined by VYC yardstick as adjusted by the handicapper. Prizes will be given as follows:

Jack Holt Regatta: 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall:

1st, 2nd & 3rd Junior Skipper (skipper and crew 17 or under at 05/05/12)

May Day Regatta: 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 AUD
